Day 1: SINGAPORE → DARWIN

Upon arrival in Darwin Airport, transfer to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day free at leisure.

DAY 2: DARWIN – KAKADU – DARWIN

World Heritage listed and the largest National Park in Australia, Kakadu is one of the most diverse landscapes you'll ever experience, and you'll be amazed at the population of wildlife in the water, on the land and in the air. See some of the most amazing terrain Australia has to offer on your way to and inside Kakadu. Marvel at the concentration of rock art sites that illustrate Aboriginal culture, some dating back 50,000 years.

Itinerary:

- **Kakadu National Park** - Travelling along the Arnhem Highway, the Marrakai Plains will provide a beautiful backdrop for your journey.
- **Warradjan Cultural Centre** - Call in to learn more about the region. Bininj people - Learn about the traditional owners of Kakadu.
- **Yellow Water Billabong Cruise** - Join a local guide to spot saltwater crocodiles and colourful birdlife, including sea eagles, brolgas and tiny brilliantly-hued kingfishers.
- **Estuarine Crocodiles** - See them basking in the shallows and on the sandy banks. Lunch - Enjoy time out at Cooinda Lodge.
- **Nourlangie** - Walk with your Driver Guide to view many different forms of Aboriginal rock art at this site.
- Optional: Scenic Flight - Fly over the Kakadu escarpment.



DAY 3: DARWIN - LITCHFIELD

Established in 1986, Litchfield National Park is a stunning location. You can take in the splendour of thundering waterfalls, rainforest pockets and historic sacred sites. It is a haven for hundreds of native bird species and the plateau supports a rich range of woodland flora. The traditional custodians of the Park are the Wagait people, many of whom still call the area home.

Itinerary:

- **Florence Falls** - View the double falls from a high vantage point before making your way down to take a swim in the plunge pool.
- **Interpretive Guided walk** - There's time for a walk through the scenic bush and monsoon vine forest.
- **Tolmer Falls** - This is a spectacular photo opportunity; it's home to colonies of rare ghost and orange horseshoe bats.
- **Lunch** - Take a break at the Litchfield Cafe.
- **Wangi Falls** - Swim in the large plunge pool, the most accessible of all in the region and the perfect place for a final dip today.
- **Howard Springs Nature Park** - Feed the barramundi and turtles.
- **Magnetic Termite Mounds** - The work of local termites, standing upright like magnetic compasses, they make for a fun photo.

D2 Darwin City Sights

Darwin is Australia's only tropical capital city and is the largest city in the Northern Territory. It is a former frontier outpost and the gateway to Kakadu National Park. Darwin is treasured country to its traditional owners, the Larrakia people, who are prominent and active members of the local community. A multicultural city, it boasts a population made up of people from more than 60 nationalities and 70 different ethnic backgrounds.



Darwin Aviation Museum - Learn about Darwin's aviation history. B-52 Bomber - See one, on permanent loan from the United States Air Force, among 19 aircraft on display.

Air-raid on Darwin - View some rare amateur footage of this and original footage from Japanese archives.

Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory – There's time here to explore.

Aboriginal art - View the largest permanent display of Aboriginal in Australia here.

Darwin Botanic Gardens – Learn about the gardens' natural and cultural history. One of the few botanic gardens in the world that has marine and estuarine plants naturally in its grounds. And see - Unique exotic plants and local wildlife. Tour Darwin City - Take in the must-see sights.



D7 Jumping Crocs and Nature Adventure

Spectacular Crocodile Cruises takes you on the Adelaide River to educate you on crocodile biology, territorial habits, and their value to the eco system. On this cruise your wildlife guide offers the crocs a taste of buffalo meat in return for them swimming out to say hello and show their incredible hunting techniques. Enjoy the views across the Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve. Adelaide River Cruise - spot at least one of over 1,600 crocodiles. Watch - these creatures leap out of the water for a taste of buffalo meat. Crocodile biology - learn about this, crocs territorial habits and their value to the eco system Also see - an amazing array of birdlife. Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve - view impressive scenery year-round, and as the wetlands recede, the dam becomes a birdwatcher's paradise.



D11 Katherine Gorge Cruise and Edith Falls

Katherine Gorge is located within amazing Nitmiluk National Park, which spans more than 292,000 hectares. With rugged landscapes, thundering waterfalls and unlimited flora and fauna, Nitmiluk is a haven for adventurers and nature lovers alike. The name Nitmiluk, meaning “Cicada Place”, came from the Jawoyn people who are the traditional custodians of the Park.

Stuart Highway – Travel along Australia’s longest highway en route to your destination.

Adelaide River War Cemetery – Dedicated to the casualties of the Bombing of Darwin

Nitmiluk National Park – See varied landscapes, waterfalls, and diverse flora and fauna.

Leliyn (Edith Falls) – Visit here (and take a refreshing swim in the dry season).

Aboriginal rock art – Throughout Nitmiluk view ancient art that expresses in images the deep spiritual culture of the Park’s custodians.

Jawoyn people – Learn about the traditional owners of Nitmiluk.

Lunch – Relax in a shaded outdoor setting.

Nitmiluk Visitor Centre – You’re free to spend time here to see photographs, memorabilia and traditional Aboriginal artefacts.

Katherine Gorge – Enjoy a two-hour cruise through the stunning gorge with its 70-metre-high walls.

Freshwater Crocodiles – Keep your eyes peeled for these, as well as wonderful birdlife and amazing scenery.
