Day 1: SINGAPORE → ADELAIDE

Airport transfer to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day free at leisure.

DAY 2: ADELAIDE – BAROSSA (FOOD & WINE EXPERIENCE)

(B/L)

The Adelaide Hills is only a short drive from the Adelaide CBD, but a long way from the hustle and bustle of the city streets. Home to the Mt Lofty Ranges, dotted with unique and historic villages, cellar doors and spectacular landscapes, this tour will give you a taste of the region. Drive along North Terrace, Adelaide's cultural precinct, on the way to Mount Lofty Summit, Adelaide's highest peak. Take in the spectacular views of the city and the coastline for a perfect photo opportunity.

Wind your way through the Adelaide Hills villages of Crafers, Stirling, Aldgate and Bridgewater before arriving at the **Beerenberg Farm Shop**, where there is time to taste and purchase from their full range of products. Then it's on to Hahndorf, Australia's oldest German settlement.

Spend the afternoon exploring the main street of Hahndorf where you can sample local produce, check out the local arts and crafts before enjoying afternoon tea or a traditional German beer tasting at the very popular Hahndorf Inn.

DAY 3: ADELAIDE – KANGAROO ISLAND - ADELAIDE

An early morning pick-up from your hotel for a scenic coach transfer to **Cape Jervis** taking in the picturesque **Fleurieu Peninsula** with its vineyards, coastal views and rolling hills. On arrival, board the SeaLink ferry for the 45-minute crossing to Penneshaw on **Kangaroo Island**. Here you will board your luxury SeaLink coach, and your local driver/guide will take you on a tour of South Australia's premier nature-based tourism destination.



Visit **Seal Bay Conservation Park** where you will be taken on a guided beach walk with an experienced guide and be amongst a colony of rare Australian sea lions. Get up close and see these wild creatures frolic and laze about, a truly amazing and unforgettable experience. Then enjoy a delicious two course lunch at Vivonne Bay Bistro, located on the south coast of Kangaroo Island. Spend the afternoon in the **Flinders Chase National Park**, which was devastated in the worst fire to ever hit the island in January 2020. You'll see that the regeneration of the native bush occurs so quickly after the event and there will be many opportunities to take photos.



As you travel through the park, keep an eye out for echidnas, wallabies, reptiles, and koalas. See the rugged coastline from walks around **Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch**. Remarkable Rocks provide great photographic opportunities, and the Admirals Arch boardwalk takes you down a rugged cliff face to reveal the spectacular rock archway, a natural nursery and safe haven for playful Long-nosed Fur Seals. Your last visit of the day is to the **Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park** to feed some kangaroos and get up close to the Kangaroo Island Koalas while listening to the Keeper talk about the cuddly mammals. There may be a photo opportunity to hold a Koala (additional cost). There is also a possibility that you will see more kangaroos and wallabies on your way to your chosen overnight accommodation.

DAY 4: ADELAIDE → SINGAPORE

AS23 - Full Day Murray River Highlights with Lunch



Relax while taking a lunch-time cruise along the historic Murray River. Gain an insight into this unique river system with its magnificent landscapes and spectacular cliffs. Then travel alongside the Murray River in your coach, taking in the spectacular views and stopping regularly for great photo opportunities. On the return journey, visit Melba's Chocolate Factory and Woodside Cheese Wrights at Woodside. Itinerary: The Murray River Highlights tour departs Adelaide and travels to the mighty Murray. On your arrival at the river you will board the Proud Mary and relax as you cruise the historic river enjoying the wildlife and surrounding scenery. Enjoy lunch on board the Proud Mary as you continue your journey along the river and gain insight into the river system and unique landscapes of the region. Upon disembarking you will

journey on an incredible coach tour along the river bank of the Murray River taking in spectacular views, travelling over the river on punts and stopping regularly for great photo opportunities, including the Mannum Lookout. Travel back to Adelaide via the delightful Adelaide Hills, stopping at Melba's Chocolate Factory where you can purchase afternoon tea and delight in cheese tastings at Woodside Cheese Wrights in Woodside (both at own expense).



AS18 - Full Day Victor Harbor and Southern Highlights (Without Lunch)

Enjoy a delightful tour of South Australia's premier tourist region, the Fleurieu Peninsula. This tour begins with a picturesque coach ride through the Adelaide Hills to the historical Scottish settlement of Strathalbyn. Here you will stop for some free time and morning tea in High Street (own expense). Continue on to the paddle steamer town of Goolwa where you will have a brief tour of the town including the wharf, barrage and beach. On your way to Victor Harbor, travel past the charming coastal town of Port Elliot including Horseshoe Bay and stop at Whale Lookout for a photo opportunity. Upon arrival at Victor Harbor, South Australia's most popular

seaside village, wander through the main street, sampling the fresh local product. You may choose to explore Granite Island, where you'll find the Little Penguins and you might even catch a glimpse of a Southern Right Whale during the winter months. Your tour then continues to the wine making region of McLaren Vale, best known for producing outstanding Shiraz. Wander the main street, sample the fresh local produce including the delicious cheeses at Blessed Cheese, taste some of the fine wines or grab a coffee at one of the many cafés. From here take a scenic drive through South Australia's southern metropolitan beaches of Port Noarlunga and Moana before returning to Adelaide.

AS2 - Full Day Barossa Food & Wine Experience

Travel through the city of Adelaide northwards to the world renowned **Barossa wine region**. Enjoy the change of scenery as you make your way into the vineyards of South Australia's premium wine region. Your first stop is **Pindarie**, a multi-tourism award winning cellar door, which feels more like an Australian Homestead than a cellar door. The friendly staff share their stories behind the wines as you sample their famous blends in the heritage stables. Sit back and admire their stunning vineyard views while you enjoy some morning tea.

The next stop is a visit to **Maggie Beer's Farm Shop**, an absolute must whilst visiting the Barossa. Maggie Beer's offers tastings and sales of her full product range including limited edition seasonal produce. Here you can browse amongst her personally selected regional specialty goods, purchase one of her signed books or simply sit back and take in the view.

On arrival at **Lambert Estate at Angaston**, you will enjoy a **structured wine tasting** whilst sampling local seasonal produce from gourmet platters. Main course follows, and is a feast for the senses, with two signature dishes, salad and vegetables. You may wish to purchase a glass of wine from the impressive wine selection, or enjoy a coffee accompanied with their popular Chocolatier (Chocolate Port). Leaving Lambert Estate, travel to **Mengler Hill**. Lookout for sweeping views over the valley and then onto the **Barossa Valley Chocolate Company** your final stop for the day. Here you will taste house made chocolates paired with Vineyard Road's handcrafted wines which will be a great way to finish off our Barossa Food and Wine Experience.
