ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL TO PERTH

Upon arrival to airport transfer to hotel, free time at leisure to explore the largest city of the Australian state of Western Australia.

DAY 2: PERTH – HALF DAY PERTH & FREMANTLE CITY TOUR (Breakfast)

Today starting in Perth, the **half day tour** takes in all major attractions, including the Western Australian Cricket Ground (WACA). Then on to King Park botanical gardens, where you have time to experience a walk through the trees canopies on the Tree Top Walkway. Later, continues to Cottesloe Beach before arriving at historical **Fremantle**. Take a stroll at the bustling, dynamic port city or just relax with a coffee and indie vibe at the many restaurants and cafes.

DAY 3: FULL DAY TOUR (Breakfast/Picnic Lunch)

Today, wait for your Seat-In-Coach transfer service to your choice of day tours.

DAY 4: FULL DAY TOUR (Breakfast/Picnic Lunch)

Choice of ONE of the following tours:

1) Margaret River, Cave, Wine, Busselton Jetty

Margaret River is one of Australia's finest wine regions and blessed with stunning natural beauty. Stop for morning tea (own expense) at the iconic Busselton Jetty, the longest timber jetty in the Southern Hemisphere. Head to one of the Margaret River's oldest breweries for a gourmet platter lunch of local produce, with complimentary beer and cider tastings. Continue south to an internationally renowned winery to taste some of the best wines in the region, whilst gaining industry insights. Next it's a Mammoth Cave guided tour, then pass through the Boranup Forest to be captivated by the size of the Karri trees. Then off to Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse, the dividing point between the Southern and Indian Oceans. End of the day, stop at Margaret River township to stroll the main street.

2) Wave Rock, York, Wildflowers (seasonal) & Aboriginal Culture

A journey through WA's wheat belt to Wave Rock, truly one of Australia's most incredible natural landforms. Heading east we enjoy morning tea (own expense) at historic York, the first township founded in the Avon Valley. Then visit Hippo's Yawn, a rock formation which resembles a hippo yawning. We then break for a lunch at the Wildflower Shop. See the spectacular Wave Rock and the ancient Gnamma Holes. Whilst here visit either a Wildlife Park or view a unique Antique Lace Collection. Leaving Wave Rock we visit The Humps and finally Mulka's Cave. We return to Perth with a stop at the quaint country town of Babakin for afternoon tea (own expense).

Note: Profusion of the wildflowers depends on weather and other conditions.

3) **4WD Sand Dune / Sand Boarding / Koalas / Pinnacles**

This fabulous day out explores the world-renowned Pinnacles Desert, an amazing moon-like landscape. After stopping at Caversham Wildlife Park in the Swan Valley to view koalas and hand feed the kangaroos, we travel along quiet back roads, to the lobster fishing town of Cervantes for a picnic lunch where you can upgrade to lobster lunch with additional cost. Then it's onwards to the mystical Pinnacles Desert for an easy paced walk through the fascinating landscape before giving you the thrilling experience of sand boarding and 4-wheel driving over the vast sand dunes of Lancelin.

4) **Pinnacles, New Norcia Benedict History & Seasonal Wildflowers including fish and chip lunch**

Experience some of Western Australia's unique natural and cultural gems on this fascinating full-day tour from Perth. Get a taste of authentic Spanish art and architecture in the quaint town of New Norcia and get chance to visit museums and art galleries to learn about the Aboriginal Mission in Western Australia. You may also go on to try famed local produce: from olive oil to fruits, nut cakes and wine. Experience the area's famous wildflowers, blossoming from September to early November. Then, complete the experience with an adventure in the beautiful Pinnacles Desert
